## **Technical Document on sending Paid Content**

When the OnlyFans account is less than four months old, you cannot sell PPVs for more than \$100.

So you must follow a special technique to be able to sell a PPV for more than \$100, whether they are in a script, or in the menu.

## 1. During a Script

When you're in a script, you're in pure sexting. So talking about money is never profitable, but you're going to have to...

When you arrive at the time to send the video... you must obviously always notify the fan that you are going to prepare it:

"Let me prepare it for you (nickname) "



And you will have to add:

"Could you please tip me (the amount) also (nickname) before I sent you the video, thank you (nickname) "S"

To determine the amount: Overall PPV amount - \$100 Case study:

You will sell the PPV for \$150.

You must ask for \$50 worth of Tips, and put \$100 on the PPV. The total amount will be \$150.

If the customer doesn't understand why, you will have to explain the following:

"I can't put more than \$150 on the PPV, my OF account is less than 4 months old:/you trust me anyway (nickname) ""

Once you receive the tips, you must tell him again:

"Thank you so muuuch, I'm gonna prepare the video now, I'm so fucking excited (name ) that's amazing how you turned me on oh my god "And please don't cum I want to finish with you so bad



## 2. For a Custom

For Customs, you must always collect Tips first.

If the customer ever wants to play a game in Tips, and a PPV at the end, you must accept, this poses no problem.

Always the same calculation:

If the Custom is \$400, you ask for: \$300 in Tips, and you put \$100 on the PPV.

Obviously, if you are in a sexting session (customs made live), you must be as natural as possible:

"Oh my god I'm so turned on, let me prepare the video for you (nickname), could please just tip me before

## 3. For the Menu

For a video from the menu, which you wish to sell for more than \$100, you will have to recover the remaining amount in Tips.

You must follow the same procedure in your calculations:

To determine the amount: Overall PPV amount - \$100 Case study:

You will sell the PPV for \$150.

You must ask for \$50 worth of Tips, and put \$100 on the PPV. The total amount will be \$150.

Here is a message template to send to the customer:

"(Nickname), could you please tip me (the amount needed) before sending the video? send it right "" "I'll after

If the customer doesn't understand why, you will have to explain the following:

"I can't put more than \$150 on the PPV, my OF account is less than 4 months old:/you trust me anyway (nickname) "

Once you receive the tips, you must thank them and send the PPV immediately afterwards:

"Awww babe thank you so muuuch I'm sending you the video now you'll become crazy
